



AVG Free 2012 Installation Instructions

Warning: These instructions only pertain to the AVG 2011 version to AVG 2012 version upgrade. Please check the AVG web site if you have an older version of AVG.

1. If you already have a version of AVG 2011 antivirus installed on your computer, a window may pop up saying "AVG Anti-virus Free **needs to be updated**". The complete installation takes about 30 minutes depending on the size and model of your computer. If you wish to continue, click on the **Free Update** command button.
2. The Initializing installation window will appear and stay like this for several minutes.
3. The Upgrade to AVG 2012 window will appear. Click on the **Accept** command button.
4. The Select the product you wish to install window appears. Click on the **Basic protection** radio button and click on the **Next** command button.
5. The Install the AVG Security Toolbar window appears. **Uncheck** the two boxes on this window and click on the **Next** command button.
6. The Install Progress window will appear and the progress bar will go across the page. This may take about 10 to 15 minutes.
7. The Upgrade to AVG 2012 has been successful window appears. Click on the **Restart Now** command button.
8. After your computer is up and running again, click on the AVG 2012 desktop icon to open AVG. Click on the **Tools >> Advanced settings...** menu option.
9. The Advanced AVG Settings window will appear. Click on the "+" sign beside Schedules on the left side of the window. Then click on **Scheduled scan**. Make sure the **Run at a specific time interval radio button** is selected. Use the drop down box to use **Selected days**. Change the time to **12:00 am** and **uncheck the box that says Run on computer startup if task has been missed**. Click on the **Apply** command button.
10. Click on the **Virus database update schedule** on the left side of the window. Make sure the **Run even if computer is in low power mode** and **Run the update again after the internet connection is available** checkboxes are unchecked and click on the **Apply** command button.
11. Click on the **Program update schedule** on the left side of the window. Make sure the **Run even if computer is in low power mode** and **Run the update again after the internet connection is available** checkboxes are unchecked and click on the **Apply** command button.
12. Click on the **OK** command button and then close the AVG antivirus window. You are now fully protected on your computer.
